**PLEASE READ:**

1. When entering Eagle Creek Park gates (56<sup>th</sup> or 71<sup>st</sup>), please inform the gate staff that you are with the “Home School Jamboree” and give them the name as listed for your group so you will not be charged to enter the park.
2. Please bring a sack lunch. Students will have @ 45 minutes for lunch.
3. PLEASE dress for the weather. Unless there is thunder and lightening, the program will not be canceled. Some of the programs are indoors and some are outdoors.
4. Park in designated areas only. Additional parking is at the fitness trail and along that road. A map will follow...
5. If you are going to be dropping your child off, we ask that when you sign in to inform us so we can get an emergency # to reach you throughout the day. Each participant will have a name-tag of their daily schedule. Volunteers will be stationed around to assist participants on where they need to go for each program.
6. Please try to be here no later than 10a so everyone can get checked in and we can get the programs started promptly at 10:30a.
7. If you (adult) are staying with your participant(s), we ask that all cell phones are turned off and that younger siblings are under control and not disrupting the program. This will help each participant get the most out of their learning experience.
